Project Overview

Bennett Architectural were asked to supply the architectural aluminium glazing systems for the new teaching block at Shireland Collegiate Academy.

The multi-phased development included a new teaching block and dining room extension to the Smethwick-based school.

Our involvement in the scheme included fabricating and installing Kawneer's AA540 Windows, AA100 Curtain Walling, AA3610 Vertical Sliding Window and AA190 TB Doors.

Due to this project being part of the Education sector, safety was of optimum importance which led to the AA540 being the window of choice due to its espagnolette locking and key locking handles which provide extra security.

The AA3610 Sliding Window was selected for this project due to its ability to allow maximum ventilation, a feature that is highly important in education settings.

This is achieved by using a linked sash where the top and bottom of the window can be opened simultaneously to allow stale air out of the top and fresh air to be drawn in at the bottom, without the need for actuators or teleflex.

The project reached completion in the Spring of 2019.
